We have provided a quick graphic below to guide students and families on handling any such situation.

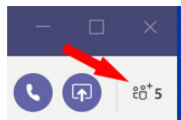
What to do About Inappropriate Chats

If you are in Chat on a PC in Microsoft Teams

- find this icon in the top right corner of your chat screen
- click on it and you will see a dropdown menu
- select "Leave" (under participant names)



If you are in Chat on an iPad in Microsoft Teams

- Click on the chat name at the top of your screen (to the right)
- find the "Leave chat" icon and click on it



If you are in Chat on a Chromebook in Microsoft Teams find the ellipses (dots) at the top right corner and select leave
